Make an impact while you enjoy time with friends & family! From as far away as Boston, to all over Morgan County and Central Indiana, people are showing their support for Stability First by walking or running in our Rally in the Valley Virtual 5K. As a COVID-safe alternative to our traditional spring 5K, a partnership with the Runners Stay Strong program allows you to participate a healthy, fun event with friends near and far.

WHAT IS A VIRTUAL 5K? It's an opportunity to walk or run in support of Stability First, on any day, at any time, in any location between now and June 30th. This allows participants to safely follow any social distancing practices they feel are appropriate for their circumstances. Walk or run alone, with family members or with a group of friends or co-workers. **Participants simply register to participate at <http://bit.ly/S-F5K>**, they pay a \$20 registration fee (plus a small processing fee), and download the race app. 100% of the \$20 fee goes to support Stability First! On the selected date start the app and it will keep track of the distance being ran or walked. When the 3.1 miles have been completed the app will send the time back to Stability First. At the end of the month, we will look at all times posted and determine winners. We will send that info to all participants and invite everyone to our **Post-race Celebration Event scheduled for Thurs. July 30th from 7 – 8:30 p.m. on Martinsville's Courthouse Square.** Held in conjunction with the Cruise-In on the Square, the celebration will include awards, music and an old fashioned and ice cream social.

COVID-19 CRISIS CAN'T KEEP KIM DOWN

Meet Kim who arrived at the Magdalene House in 2019, on the verge of suicide....

How does an honor roll student who graduated at 17 end up suicidal & homeless?
 by letting others devalue her worth and influence her choices.

At 22, Kim gave birth to twins, a baby boy & a baby girl!

Kim worked hard and earned enough credits to graduate when she was 17

In her early 20's Kim enrolled in Ivy Tech. She earned 40+ credits toward a degree in nursing.

After several months of hard work, Kim graduated from our DETOUR (in-house substance abuse recovery) Program.

A series of destructive relationships left Kim with a drug habit and feelings of worthlessness. Staring at an eviction notice with nowhere to go, she was seriously contemplating suicide when someone from the Magdalene House called to let her know they had a bed for her.

TODAY Kim is still moving upward! She's reaching out to Ivy Tech, making plans to re-enroll this fall. AND, she's grateful to have her grandchildren back in her life.

Kim was featured in a newspaper article about the Maggie Bag Project. She loves the feeling of accomplishment when all of the steps are completed and a new bag is finished! During the COVID-19 crisis, Kim and her Magdalene House roommates used their sewing skills to make protective masks for guests at hospitals & clinics.
